Junior riders are ages 11 and under as of January 1st of the current year.

Youth Riders are ages 12-17 as of January 1st of the current year.

Senior riders are 18+ as of January 1st of the current year.

Horse/Rider combinations showing walk/trot/jog are limited to ONLY walk/trot/jog classes at any one show (including gaming classes). EXCEPTION: PAIRS will be open to ALL horse/rider combinations, but the class will be limited to walk-trot only for safety.

Open classes are free of AGE restrictions but Walk/Jog and Walk/Jog/Lope entry restrictions still apply

OVER FENCES: Each class is one trip only; horse/rider combo may only enter 2 consecutive heights maximum (ex. No entry in both crossrail & 2'; Crossrail & 18" or 18" and 2' are acceptable.)

Classes may be combined or split at the discretion of the executive and/or judge based on entry counts. Split classes will be pinned separately with one set of ribbons/points awarded per split; all points will count towards year end award for that class.
