Junior riders are ages 11 and under as of January 1st of the current year.

Youth Riders are ages 12-17 as of January 1st of the current year.

Senior riders are 18+ as of January 1st of the current year.

Horse/Rider combinations showing walk/trot/jog are limited to ONLY walk/trot/jog classes at any one show, this includes gaming classes. EXCEPTION: PAIRS will be open to ALL horse/rider combinations, but the class will be limited to walk-trot only for safety.

Open classes are free of AGE restrictions but Walk/Jog and Walk/Jog/Lope entry restrictions still apply.

TRAIL will be set up in the MAIN show pen the night before. MAIN show pen will be open for warm up through Class #4; riders will need to work around the trail obstacles as they are not open for schooling.

Classes 1-5 will run in the SMALL PEN (warm up ring). Classes 34 and 35 will also run in SMALL PEN to allow over fences set up in the MAIN show pen.

Horse/Rider combinations may enter a maximum of 2 consecutive heights over fences for classes 37-39 (Ex. Classes 37 & 38, or 38 & 39, but not 37 & 39).

Classes may be combined or split at the discretion of the executive and/or judge based on entry counts.
